Being Risk Aware Online Course Overview

This Risk Management Awareness course is designed for eLearning delivery to employees in all occupations and at all levels within an organisation. Its purpose is to assist in developing a shift towards a culture of risk awareness. It is intended as an introduction to the understanding and application of the Risk Management function whether it be from a strategic, planning or operational viewpoint. This course is the first step in understanding basic concepts about being risk aware and about risk management in general. It has been designed generically and will not necessarily talk to specific job functions, management requirements or executive functions. The course consists of 'content', 'tutorials' and 'tests'. The tutorials set scenarios or ask questions which re-enforce the content. A question is posed with each scenario which must be answered by the participant. Feedback is given as to why the selected answer is correct or incorrect. The tutorials describe a range of scenarios (not only workplace) in order to make participants aware that risk applies everywhere and at all times. However, these tutorials and tests can easily be made Organisation specific.
